Skills, Values and Attitudes

A key element of the subject is to encourage all pupils to:

- Work with others, listen to other's ideas and treat others with respect.
- Have opportunities to consider their own experiences, attitudes and values, and those of other people.
- Develop respect for evidence and critically evaluate ideas that may or may not fit the evidence available.
- Identify puzzling questions and suggest answers.
- Develop an understanding of why certain things are held to be right or wrong.
- Build on previous learning.

Unit 4B: Celebration: Christmas journeys

Unit 4C: Why is Easter important for Christians?

Unit 4D: What religions are represented in our neighbourhood?
