After-school care is available after 3.00 pm daily with the additional provision of tea, which will be served at 5.00pm for all children booked until 6.00pm. Additional refreshments are served during the afternoon session and at the end of the formal school day for pupils attending After-School care.

After-School Care (Reception to Year 6) charged at £5.75 per hour/part hour per day.

- There are 3 terms per year
- If a child is collected later than agreed, an additional hourly rate will be charged, to ensure that staff: pupil ratios are maintained.

Sibling discounts are provided at the rate of 5% for the second child and 10% for the third and subsequent children who attend any department of the School at the same time.

West House School claims Nursery Education Grant funding on behalf of parents of all eligible children pro rata for child attending between one and ten sessions per week. Nursery vouchers can be used to pay nursery fees, after-school care and holiday club for children under the age of 16 years. Nursery Education Grant is reduced pro rata for a child attending fewer than five sessions per week. Nursery vouchers can be used to pay nursery fees, after-school care and holiday club for children under the age of 16 years. A £19.00 fee is charged per term to cover administration costs.

A non-refundable Registration fee of £75 per child is payable.

Fees may be paid by cheque, online banking, debit or credit card or via School Fee Plan. The school does not accept payment in cash. Should you wish to deposit cash directly into the school's bank account details can be found on the fee bill. Fees may be paid monthly through Schools Fee Plan scheme. Further details for any of these methods of payment can be obtained upon request from the Bursar.

All Fee accounts are payable before the first day of term. However, a period of seven days' grace is allowed to cover possible unavoidable delays in remitting fees. Thereafter a surcharge on outstanding accounts will be charged, without exception, at the rate of 2% per month or part of a month until fully paid.

Under no circumstances will a pupil be allowed to return at the beginning of a term when fees from a previous term be outstanding.

Parents wishing to withdraw a pupil for any reason must give **ONE FULL TERM'S** notice in writing to the Headmaster; otherwise a full term's Tuition Fee is payable.
